LESSON OBJECTIVE

This lesson will help children learn that God helps us grow by giving us jobs to do.
Bulletin Board Idea: Growing For Jesus

AS KIDS ARRIVE (10 minutes)

As kids arrive have a helper ask the the children to sit in a big circle on the floor. Ask the children what types of jobs their parents have. Do their grandparents still work, if so what type of jobs do they do? Lastly ask the children what types of jobs they may like to have when they are grown ups.

BIBLE VERSE (7 minutes)

"I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me." **Philippians 4:13 (KJV)**
Explain to the children that we can do all kinds of things with God's help that we could never do by ourselves. As we grow, God will give us many different jobs to do, but He will also give us the strength we need to do them.

BIBLE STORY (15 minutes)

God helps us grow in many different ways. God will give us jobs to do and these jobs will help us grow. God also gives us the strength we need to do these jobs. The Bible gives many examples of God giving His people jobs to do, sometimes the jobs were small and at others times the jobs were very big.

Read Colossians 3:23-24

Discussion Questions:

1. What does the Bible say about the manner in which we should work? (Work at it with all your heart)
2. What does working at it with all your heart mean? (To do your very best job)
3. The Bible also says to work like we are working for who? (God and not men)
4. God sees the work that we do. What will we receive from God? (An inheritance or reward)
5. What types of jobs do you have? (School work, jobs at home) Do you do them with your whole heart? Do you do them like you are working for God?

Preparation:

Before class, print an activity page for each child.

What you do during class:

Hand out the activity sheet and ask the children to draw a line from the cartoon character on the page to the job that character should be doing.

Once the children have finished the activity, go through each of the pictures and show the kids how you matched up the cartoon character with the jobs. Point out to the children that it may be hard for the astronaut to do the job of the firefighter. It may also be hard for the firefighter to do the job of the police officer.

Finish the activity by explaining how God gives us certain jobs to do. He also gives us the skills and talents to do these jobs. When we do the jobs God gives us with the skills and talents He also gives us, we are sure to grow.
